What is a CSA?

Community Supported Agriculture:

Consumers pledge support to local farms by purchasing subscriptions directly from the farmers. In return you receive fresh produce weekly throughout the growing season.



Why participate in a CSA?

- Know **how and where your food is grown**. Members are invited to visit the farm during the growing season.
- Receive **fresh healthy food** for your family each week.
- Because produce is picked just prior to delivery, **flavor is unmatched** by shipped in fruits and vegetables.
- A **wide variety** of produce and easy to use recipes will liven up family meals.
- Support **Missouri farmers**.
- Keep your food dollars in the **local community**.

How does *Lee Farms CSA* work?

Families or individuals buying a subscription pay 50% up front to reserve their produce. The remaining 50% is due by June 30th.

Then, once per week from mid-June through October a box of local produce is brought to a conveniently located pick-up site for each family participating. Volunteers are needed once per week to host the sites. Discounts will be given to those who serve as a host pick-up location.

Pick-Up Locations

Current pick-up sites are located in the neighborhoods of Central West End, Old North and South City. New pick-up locations can be established if there is interest in your neighborhood.

Share Sizes

Two sizes of produce shares are available. A **Full Share** will feed a family of four and averages 15 to 20 pounds of produce per week for a cost of \$595.

A **Half Share** will feed a family of two, averaging 7 to 10 pounds of produce per week for a cost of \$395.
